There has been no change in the above referenced facility concerning waste tires storage, and the facility is operating in compliance with the permit requirements. The maximum number of tires that can be stored onsite is 5300 tires. The anticipated disposal cost for the maximum storage quantity is calculated as follows:

2021 Disposal Cost Estimate = \$5574.78 FDEP Inflation Multiplier 2021 = 1.041

2022 Disposal Cost Estimate \$5508.68 x 1.041 = \$5803.34
