If an unplanned closing should occur at the Florida Tire Terminal facility in Avon Park, Fl, the following costs would apply. Florida Tire Terminal has received a letter from Macks Tire Recyclers (Attached) stating the cost to load and remove all tires is \$131.50 per ton.

The actual waste tire quantities on hand and the weights associated with each category are the results of an inventory taken on 11-24-08 in cooperation with Polston Engineering. These figures reflect the actual inventory of tires in each of the storage areas that are indicated on the Facility Plan.

Passenger and Light Truck Tires-475 units at 26 lbs./unit=12,350 lbs which is equivalent to 6.17 tons.

Truck Tires-2824 units at 135 lbs/unit=381,240 lbs which is equivalent to 190.62 tons.

Large Truck Tires -618 Units at 195 lbs/unit=120,510 lbs which is equivalent to 60.25 tons.

The total of waste tires equals 257.05 tons.

The following calculation applies.

257.05 tons of waste tires x \$131.50/ton of waste tire abatement costs = \$33,802.07.

The 3917 total tires is well below the 15,000 unit maximum limit that the alternative procedures plan dictates.

The Figure of \$33,802.07 represents the total closing cost using \$131.50/ton as the removal cost per ton stated in the letter from Macs Tire recycling.
