The District and Business Support Program (DBSP) has reviewed the Site Rehabilitation Report (SRCR) Response to Comments (RTC), dated March 31, 2020, submitted by Gannett Fleming, Inc. for Coca-Cola Foods (Former Minute Maid – Dunedin Plant) (site).

An Amendment to the Natural Attenuation Monitoring (NAM) Plan Approval Order for this site, which alters the Agency ordered action levels, or record of such an amendment being issued could not be located. Please provide a copy of the NAM Order Amendment that redefines the action level for arsenic in well MW-8D to 205 micrograms per liter. Please be advised that an informal communication such as an email or documentation of verbal approval to change the action levels are insufficient to alter an agency order.

A minimum of two groundwater monitoring events must be performed to demonstrate that groundwater contaminant concentrations remain below action levels and satisfy the conditions for closure. An event in which a contaminant concentration exceeds an action level in the NAM Order cannot be considered as one of the two consecutive events used to demonstrate that the plume is stable or shrinking; therefore, at least one more sampling event must be completed in order to satisfy the February 5, 2019 NAM Plan Approval Order and the conditions of Rule 62-780.690(8)(g), Florida Administrative Code.

I think they make a fair point in that they responded to the action level exceedance with one NAM event, and (including the event with the action level exceedance) they have at least two consecutive events demonstrating closure conditions are satisfied. What this boils down to is, can that event with an action level exceedance be considered one of the two consecutive events required for closure.
