The inflation-adjusted cost estimates received March 25, 2009 (total for closure \$22,521.66), are **APPROVED for 2009**. The above referenced facility has experienced no changes and is operating in compliance with the permit requirements. The maximum quantity of tires allowed to be stored on site is 205 tons. The anticipated disposal cost for the maximum storage quantity is calculated as follows:

2008 Disposal Cost Estimate = \$21,972.35
FDEP Inflation 2009 Multiplier = 1.025
2009 Disposal Cost Estimate (1.025 x \$21,972.35) = \$22,521.66
