The purpose of this letter is to inform the Florida Department of Environmental Protection (FDEP) that the sampling of groundwater monitoring well network and surface water locations for Phases 1 through 3 in accordance with the revised Monitoring Plan Implementation Schedule (MPIS) is scheduled to commence on 26 May 2009. The work will be performed over an approximate one week period. The sampling is being performed at the end of the month with the hope that most of the closure construction work will be complete by this time. This notification satisfies the requirements as described in the specific condition 14 of the Permit (i.e., paragraph 17 of the MPIS) and Rule 62-701.510(9)(a) F.A.C. This will be the tenth semi-annual water quality monitoring event performed at the facility.
