SUBJECT: Hazard Abatements at Florida Tire Terminal

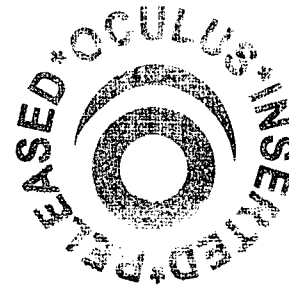

The prime requisite of this department is to maintain a series of 8' aisles at this facility; which enables us to effectively sustain a suppression effort. The constant maintenance (keeping the aisles unencumbered with tires) is imperative in whether this facility is termed hazardous to the surrounding properties or not. I have spoken with Mr. Robert Reisig concerning the aisles as well as some additional fire extinguishers and he has agreed to make the necessary changes.
