The Department has received an application package on April 11, 2006 and found it to be incomplete. Please note that the submittal does not include a response to our RAI No. 1, dated March 31, 2005; however, a general review was made. Please note that RAI No. 2, dated December 8, 2005, was regarding a meeting to discuss the storage data received by the Department on December 6, 2005. Please submit additional information as addressed below to complete the application.

1. Please submit a response (letter) to our RAI No. 1 addressing each item and furnishing exact reference(s) to the documents included in the application package.
2. Please check (✓) the box for "Existing unpermitted facility". This was the first comment in our RAI No. 1. Please note that the facility has been in operation for several years, but the box for "Proposed new facility" is checked (✓) on the revised application, submitted in the package received April 11, 2006.

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
3. The submitted package does not include an Application Narrative. Please submit an Application Narrative addressing each item.
4. Please submit a description of the proposed construction in the Application Narrative and submit drawings/plans. Please note that PART I.B.8 indicates a date, "5-01-06" for starting the construction and a date, "12-01-06" for completion of construction. Please note that the submitted package does not include any information about the proposed construction.
5. Please delete, "& Son in Law of the owner..." from PART I.E.5, because the relationship of the Manager to any person is irrelevant. Moreover, please note that the owner is not a person but a business, "Beck's Tire Service", as entered at PART I.C.1 of the Application Form.
6. Application Form, PART III.A.2. Plot Plan: Please note that Florida Tire Terminal does not process waste tires as defined in Florida Administrative Code (F.A.C.) Rule 62-701.200(137); therefore, delete the word "PROCESSING" from the labels for the areas, probably used for retreading/repairing shown on the Facility Plan. Please use some appropriate word, other than processing.
7. As required by the application, PART III.A.2.d, please label "boundaries of the facility, legal boundaries of the land containing the facility and any easements or right-of-ways that are within the facility or within 200 feet of any storage area" on the Facility Plan.
8. Application Form, PART III.A.2.f: Please see Comment 4 above regarding the proposed construction and address it.
9. Application Form, PART III.B.5: The description in the attachment does not include the waste tire storage capacities of the designated areas, and the capacities are not indicated on the Facility Plan as stated. Please furnish the capacities in the designated areas with their identification and indicate them on the Facility Plan.
10. Application Form, PART III-B-1: Please modify the description in the attachment using an appropriate word, other than "Processed". Please modify the description accordingly in the attachment for PART III-B-8.

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11. Application Form, PART III.C: The submitted "Tire Inventory Estimate" does not describe the storage cells as designated on the Facility Plan, TIRE CELL 1, TIRE CELL 2, etc.
12. Application Form, PART III-D: Please note that Beck's Tire Service DBA Florida Tire Terminal, is not "legally incorporated in the State of Florida" as stated in the attachment for PART III-E-1, Authorization letter; therefore, it is not entitled to assume the financial responsibility for closure of the facility. Please note that a permit cannot be issued to a business not registered in the State of Florida. Please see the attached Department's memo.

Please submit at least three (3) copies of revised Application Form and the requested information within thirty (30) days of receipt of this letter. Please note that the Department will not have any option other than denying permit, if this time frame is not met.
